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Small Wheelchair Caddy ©2002, designed by Debi Scheiferstein

This caddy is just the right size to carry a book, tissues, pencil and paper. It was very popular at the Lake City, FL Veteran's home because of it's size!

4 ply yarn in your favorite color "G" hook 2 1/2"-1" buttons

(Make 2)

Ch 35

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook & in each ch across. ch 1, turn

Row 2: Hdc in same st as ch 1 and each hdc acorss, ch 1 turn (at the end of each row now and thru out)

Row 3-15: Repeat row 2, finish off.

STRAP:

Row 1: Join yarn with a sl st in 5th st of last row made. Ch 1 & 1 hdc in same st. hdc in each of the next 4 sts. ch 1, turn.

Row 2: Hdc in each st across, ch1 & turn. **Row 3-15:** Repeat row 2, finish off.

SECOND STRAP:

Row 1: Skip 15 sts, sl st in next st and hdc in this and each of the next 4. **Row 2-15:** Repeat row 3-15 of the first strap. finish off.

FINISHING:

Place both pieces together, matching rows and sl in first row of top of caddy (the row with the straps). Sc in ends of each row down side (working thru both thicknesses), 3 sc in corner, sc in each st across the bottom, 3 sc in corner and up the other side putting a sc in end of each row. Finish off.

Fold straps over to front of caddy, to measure placement for buttons and sew buttons onto the outside of piece securely.



VARIATIONS: You can use variegated yarn for this caddy. You can do straps and trim in a coordinating color. You can also do the 2 main pieces by Hdc in back loops only for a ridged effect.

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
