

# Chemo Care Caps

## Fabulous Flapper Reversible Cap

*a seamless "reverse roll" hat knit in the round*

**Suggested Needles:** size #8 & #9 16" or 20" circular needles and #9 dps

**Materials:** 1 ball Chinchilla

**Gauge:** 3 sts=1"

**Note:** L1= lift 1 with left-hand needle pick up running thread between the two needles, from back to front.

With smaller circular needle, cast on 54 sts. Knit around for 1-1/2".

\*K 8, increase 1 in next stitch. Repeat from \* around. 60 sts.

Change to larger circular needle. L1, turn to wrong side (so that the purl side is facing you). This is now the right side. Knit to 1 st before L1 and knit 2 together. (You are knitting the stitch and the L1 together. This eliminates a hole that would form from turning.) Knit around until piece measures 7" from beginning.

Begin dec. rounds, changing to dp needles when stitches don't fit around circular.

1st dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog., K4. Repeat from \* around. Knit 1 round even. 50 sts.

2nd dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog., K3. Repeat from \* around. Knit 1 round even. 40 sts.

3rd dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog., K2. Repeat from \* around. Knit 1 round even. 30 sts.

4th dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog., K1. Repeat from \* around. Knit 1 round even. 20 sts.

5th dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog. around. Knit 1 round even. 10 sts.

6th dec. round: \*Knit 2 tog. around. Knit 1 round even. 5 sts.

Break yarn, leaving 9". Thread through tapestry needle, and through sts and draw them together. End off.



## Tube Hat

**Suggested Needles:** #9 16" or 20" circular needle

**Materials:** 1 ball Chinchilla

**Gauge:** 3 sts=1"

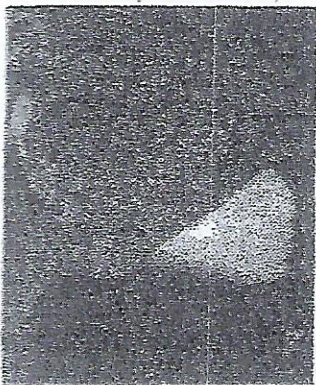
Cast on 60 sts. Knit around for 8".

Next round: \*Knit 2 tog, yo. Repeat from \* around.

Last round: Knit around.

Bind off VERY LOOSELY.

Thread ribbon or cord through eyelets. Gather and tie in bow.
