
PATTERN FOR KNITTED HEAD BAND WITH EAR COVERS

Use two strands of yarn – both of the same color or 2 different colors. Size 10 needles

Cast on 9 stitches

Knit every row for 1 ¾ inches

(1A) Starting with the next row, knit to the 4th to the last stitch, increase in the next

stitch and knit to the end of the row

(2A) On the next row, knit 3, increase in the next stitch and knit to the end of the row

Repeat directions 1A and 2A above until you have 19 stitches on your needle

Knit the next 5 rows

(1B) Knit 3 stitches, knit 2 together, knit to the end of the row

(2B) Knit to the 5th to the last stitch, knit 2 together, knit to the end of the row

Repeat directions 1B and 2B above until you have 11 stitches on your needle

Knit every row for 4 ¾ inches, depending on the firmness of the yarn

Repeat directions for 1A and 2A until you have 19 stitches on your needle

Knit the next 5 rows

Repeat directions for 1B and 2B until you have 9 stitches on your needle

Knit the next rows for 1 ¾ inches

Bind off. Leave about 10-12 inches of yarn to sew the 2 ends together. Cut the yarn. Overcast the 2 ends together. Weave any extra yarn back through the stitches where you have sewed the 2 ends together.
