

EASY CROCHET Child RIBBED HAT

Worsted weight yarn and J use a "H" hook for a female hat. <u>Maybe</u> a "G" hook would work for a child size hat. NOTE: I tried hook "J" & "K", and the hats came out way too big.

<u>Crown</u> requires 1 oz of yarn. The total weight of the finished hat is about 4 oz. depending on the yarn you choose. I've been using a mix of many little leftover balls of yarn that match, coordinated with fancy yarns and ribbon or variegated yarns which make the hats very colorful.

FPDC= Front Post Double Crochet

BPDC= Back Post Double Crochet

SS= Slip

Stitch

HAT

The Chain 3 does NOT count as a dc.

Rnd 1: CH 3 10 de in 3rd CH from Hook and then, join with SS in top of 1 st dc. (10 dc)

Rnd 2: CH 32 dc in each stitch around, then join with SS in top of 1 st dc. (20 dc)

Rnd 3: CH 3(1 dc in first stitch, 2 dc in next) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of 1 st dc. (30 de)

Rnd 4: CH 3.. (1 dc in first two stitches, 2 dc in next) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of 1st dc. (40 de)

Rnd 5: CH 3(1 dc in first three stitches, 2 dc in next) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of 1st dc. (50 de)

Rnd 6: CH 3 (1 dc in first four stitches, 2 dc in next) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of 1st dc. (60 de)

Rnd 7: CH 3 (1 dc in first five stitches, 2 dc in next) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of 1st dc. (70 de)

Rnd 8: CH 3.1 dc in **each** stitch around, then join with SS in top of 1st dc. (70 dc)

Rnds 9-15: CH 1. (FPDC in first stitch, BPDC in next stitch) Repeat around, then join with SS in top of first FPDC. (70 stitches ... 35 FPDC and 35 BPDC).

Rnds 16-18: CH l. .. hdc in each stitch around. (70 hdc)

Rnd 19: CH 1 ... sc in each stitch around. Fasten off. Weave in ends. (70sc).
