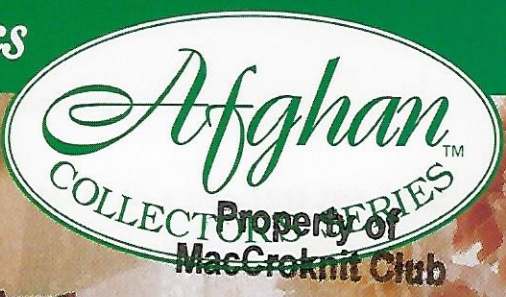

Granny Shells

SIZE: 50" {127 cm} x 61" {155 cm}.

MATERIALS: *Worsted-weight yarn — 57½ oz. {1630.1 g} green; I {5.5 mm} crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

*This project was made using Coats & Clark's "Red Heart®" yarn.

GAUGE: 3 dc sts = 1" {2.5 cm}; 8 dc rows = 5" {12.7 cm}.

SKILL LEVEL: ★ Easy

AFGHAN

Row 1: Ch 160, dc in 4th ch from

hook, dc in each ch across, turn (158 dc).

Row 2: Ch 3, skip next st, 3 dc in next st, (skip next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st) across to last 2 sts, skip next st, dc in last st, turn.

Rows 3-95: Ch 3, 3 dc in center st of each 3-dc group across, dc in top of ch-3, turn.

Row 96: Ch 3, dc in each st across, turn.

NOTE: For **picot loop (picot lp)**, ch 5, sl st in 3rd ch from hook, ch 2.

Rnd 97: Working around outer

edge, in sts, ends of rows and on opposite side of starting ch, *picot lp, sl st in next st, (picot lp, skip next 2 sts, sl st in next st) across, picot lp, skip first row, (sl st in center of next row, picot lp, skip next row, sl st in top of next row, picot lp) across to last 2 rows, sl st in center of next row, picot lp*, skip last row, sl st in first ch on opposite side of starting ch; repeat between **, join with sl st in first ch of first picot lp, fasten off.♥
