# Headliner Hats!



## \* LC1216 HEADLINER HATS

\*\* *Beginner level experience required for plain hats.*  
*Intermediate level experience required for patterned hats.*

One size fits most women.

J.&P. COATS "Speed-Cro-Sheen", 100% Cotton, Art. C45 (100 yard/110 meter balls).

Amount: One-Color Hat: 2 Balls No. 61 New Ecru CA; Two-Color Rolled Brim Hat: 2 balls NO.4 Blue CA and 1 ball No. 161 Peach CB; Two-Color Patterned Hat: 1 ball each No.1 White CA and No. 486 Navy CB; Four-Color Patterned Hat: 2 balls No. 12 Black CA, 1 ball each No. 458 Purple CB, No. 126 Spanish Red CC, and No. 431 Pumpkin CD.

Crochet Hook: U.S. Size E-4 [3.5 mm].

GAUGES: Rnds 1-18 = 6 1/2' across. In sc in the round - 20 sc = 4"; 23 rnds = 4". CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size crochet hook to obtain the gauge given.

### ONE-COLOR

#### HAT

With CA ch 4; join with a sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 6 sc in ring; do not join but mark end of rnd with a contrasting thread.

Rnd 2: [2 Sc in next sc - inc made] 6 times - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [Inc in next sc, sc in next sc] 6 times - 18 sc.

Rnd 4: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc] 6 times - 24 sc.

Rnd 5: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc] 6 times - 30 sc.

Rnd 6: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc] 6 times - 36 sc.

Rnd 7: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 5 sc] 6 times - 42 sc.

Rnd 8: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc] 6 times - 48 sc.

Rnd 9: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 7 sc] 6 times - 54 sc.

Rnd 10: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 8 sc] 6 times - 60 sc.

Rnd 11: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 9 sc] 6 times - 66 sc.

Rnd 12: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 10 sc] 6 times - 72 sc.

Rnd 13: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 11 sc] 6 times - 78 sc.

Rnd 14: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 12 sc] 6 times - 84 sc.

Rnd 15: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 13 sc] 6 times - 90 sc.

Rnd 16: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 14 sc] 6 times - 96 sc.

Rnd 17: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 15 sc] 6 times - 102 sc.

Rnd 18: [Inc in next sc, sc in next 16 sc] 6 times - 108 sc.

Increases are now completed.

Rnds 19-49: Sc in each sc around. At end of Rnd 49, sl st in next sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Roll up brim.

### TWO-COLOR ROLLED BRIM HAT

Work same as One-Color Hat through Rnd 37. Change to CB and work 12 more rnds. At end of last rnd sl st in next sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends. Roll up brim.

### TWO-COLOR PATTERNED HAT

NOTE: To change color in sc, work last st of color in progress until 2 lps remain on hook, drop color in progress; with color to be used in next st, yo and through 2 lps on hook. When working with 2 colors on a rnd, work over the strand of color not in use until needed.

With CA work Rnds 1-3 same as for One-Color Hat. Rnd 4: [With CB inc in next sc, with CA sc in next 2 sc] 6 times - 24 sc. Rnd 5: [With CB inc in next sc, sc in next 2 sc, with CA sc in next sc] 6 times - 30 sc.

NOTE: For clarity, the wording of the remaining rnds is shortened, but continue to work continuous rnds of sc with the right side facing. Work sc in the color indicated in the next number of stitch(es) specified.

Rnd 6: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 2] 6 times - 36 sc.

Rnd 7: [CB inc, CB 2, CA 1, CB 2] 6 times - 42 sc.

Rnd 8: [CB inc, CB 6] 6 times - 48 sc.

Rnd 9: [CB inc, CA 1, CB 6] 6 times - 54 sc.

Rnd 10: [CB inc, CA 3, CB 5] 6 times - 60 sc.

Rnd 11: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 1, CA 2, CB 2, CA 2] 6 times - 66 sc.

Rnd 12: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 3, CA 2, CB 2, CA 1] 6 times - 72 sc.

Rnd 13: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 2, CA 1, CB 2, CA 2, CB 2] 6 times - 78 sc.

Rnd 14: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 2, CA 3, CB 2, CA 2, CB 1] 6 times - 84 sc.

Rnd 15: [CB inc, CA 2, CB 9, CA 2] 6 times - 90 sc.

Rnd 16: rCA inc, CA 14] 6 times - 96 sc,

Rnd 17: rCA inc, CA 15] 6 times - 102 sc.

Rnd 18: rCA inc, CB 2, CA 4, CB 2, CA 4, CB 2, CA 2] 6 times - 108 sc.

Increases are now completed.

Rnd 19: CA 3, \* CB 1, CA 5; rep from \* to last 3 sc; CB 1, CA 2.

Rnd 20: Work all in CA.

Rnd 21: \* CB 2, CA 4; rep from \* around.

Rnd 22: CB 3, \* CA 2, CB 4; rep from \* to last 3 sc; CA 2, CB 1.

Rnd 23: Work all in CB.

Rnd 24: CB 1, \* CA 1, CB 5; rep from \* to last 5 sc; CA 1, CB 4.

Rnd 25: \* CA 3, CB 9; rep from \* around.

Rnd 26: CA 4, \* CB 7, CA 5; rep from \* to last 8 sc; CB 7, CA 1.

Rnd 27: CA 5, \* CB 5, CA 7; rep from \* to last 7 sc; CB 5, CA 2.

Rnd 28: \* CB 3, CA 3; rep from \* around.

Rnd 29: Work all in CA.

Rnd 30: Work all in CB.

Rnd 31: \* CB 1, \* CA 2, CB 4; rep from \* to last 5 sc; CA 2, CB 3.

Rnd 32: CB 2, \* CA 1, CB 5; rep from \* to last 4 sc; CA 1, CB 3.

Rnd 33: Work all in CB.

Rnd 34: \* CA 1, CB 5; rep from \* around.

Rnd 35: Work all in CA.

Rnd 36: Work all in CB.

Rnd 37: With CB sl st in next sc, working from LEFT to RIGHT, ch 1,

\* sc in next sc TO THE RIGHT, ch 1, skip next sc; rep from \* around;

join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

### FOUR-COLOR PATTERNED HAT

NOTE: To change color in sc, work last st of color in progress until 2 lps remain on hook, drop color in progress; with color to be used in next st, yo and through 2 lps on hook. When working with 2 colors on a rnd, work over the strand of color not in use until needed.

With CA work Rnds 1-3 same as for One-Color Hat. Rnd 4: [With CA inc in next sc, sc in next sc, with CB sc in next sc] 6 times - 24 sc. Rnd 5: [With CA inc in next sc, sc in next sc, with CB sc in next sc] 6 times - 30 sc.

NOTE: For clarity, the wording of the remaining rnds is shortened, but continue to work continuous rnds of sc with the right side facing. Work sc in the color indicated in the next number of stitch(es) specified.

Rnd 6: rCA inc, CA 1, CB 3] 6 times - 36 sc.

Rnd 7: rCA inc, CA 2, CB 3] 6 times - 42 sc.

Rnd 8: rCA inc, CA 3, CB 3] 6 times - 48 sc.

Rnd 9: rCA inc, CC 1, CA 3, CC 3] 6 times - 54 sc.

Rnd 10: rCA inc, CC 2, CA 3, CC 3] 6 times - 60 sc.

Rnd 11: rCA inc, CC 3, CA 3, CC 3] 6 times - 66 sc.

Rnd 12: rCA inc, CA 1, CC 3, CA 3, CC 3] 6 times - 72 sc.

Rnd 13: rCA inc, CA 2, CC 3, CA 3, CC 3] 6 times - 78 sc.

Rnd 14: rCA inc, CA 3, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3] 6 times - 84 sc.

Rnd 15: rCA inc, CD 1, CA 3, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3] 6 times - 90 sc.

Rnd 16: rCA inc, CD 2, CA 3, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3] 6 times - 96 sc.

Rnd 17: rCA inc, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3] 6 times - 102 sc.

Rnd 18: rCA inc, CA 1, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3, CA 3, CD 3] 6 times - 108 sc.

Increases are now completed.

Rnds 19-21: rCA 3, CB 3] 18 times.

Rnds 22-24: rCA 3, CC 3] 18 times.

Rnds 25-27: rCA 3, CD 3] 18 times.

Rnds 28-36: Rep Rnds 19-27.

Rnd 37: Work all in CA.

Rnd 38: With CA sl st in next sc, working from LEFT to RIGHT, ch 1,

\* sc in next sc TO THE RIGHT, ch 1, skip next sc; rep from \* around;

join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: beg = begin(ning); CA, CB, CC, etc. = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; ch = chain; inc = increase; mm = millimeter; rep = repeat; rnd = round; sc = single crochet; sl st = slip stitch; sp = space; st(s) = stitch(es); yo = yarn over; \* or \*\* = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated; [ ] = work directions given in brackets the number of times specified.
