Prairie Points

SIZE: 48" x 73".

MATERIALS: *Worsted-weight yarn — 21 ozs. each green (C) and lt. green (D), 17 ozs. each beige (A), med. brown (B), rust (E) and dk. brown (F); tapestry needle; J crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.

*This project was made using Caron's "Dawn Sayelle" #0387, #0386, #0303, #0382, #305A and #2033.

GAUGE: 15 sts = 4"; 7 pattern rows 2".

NOTES: When changing colors, always drop second color to same side of work. **Do not** carry dropped color across to next section of same color.

Use a separate skein of yarn for each color section. Fasten off at end of each color section.

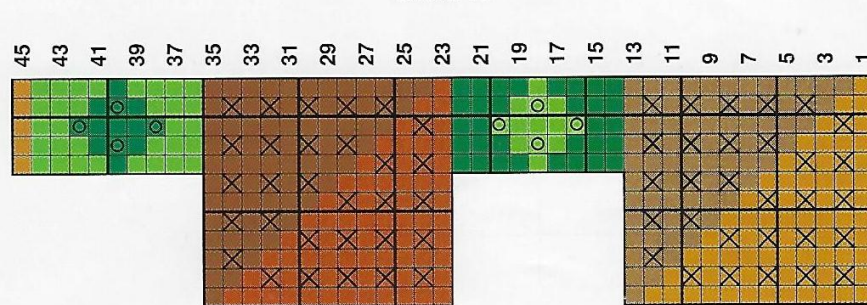
AFGHAN

Row 1: With A, ch 181, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn (180 sc).

Rows 2-45: Ch 1, work sts and change colors according to graph, turn.

Rows 46-255: Repeat rows 2-45 consecutively, ending with row 35. Fasten off at end of last row.♥
