Simple Scuffies

DIRECTIONS

Beginner

SIZE

One size fits all

MATERIALS

- Worsted weight yarn*: 5 oz each painted desert print #303 and warm brown #336, small amount of brown #328
- Size H/8 crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- · Tapestry needle

*Coats & Clark Red Heart Super Saver yarn was used in the sample project.

GAUGE

3 sc = 1 inch; 3 sc rows = 1 inch

Check gauge to save time.

PATTERN NOTES

Weave in loose ends as work progresses.

Work with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.

By working in the back lps only, scuffies will stretch to fit foot, however, for wider scuffie, simply add rows in multiples of 2.

SCUFFIE Make 2

Row 1 (RS): Holding 1 strand each painted desert print and warm brown tog, ch 55, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each rem ch across, turn. (54 sc)

Row 2: Working in back lps only, ch 1, sl st in each of next 3 sts (toe), sc in each of next 50 sts, working in both lps, sc in next st, turn.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, working in both lps, sc in next st, working in back lps only of rem sts, sc in each of next 50 sts, sl st in next 3 sts (toe), turn.

Rows 4-27: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 28: Rep Row 2, leaving long lengths of both yarns, fasten off.

Sole Trim

Row 1: With RS facing, holding 2 strands of brown tog, ch 1, beg at toe, working in rem free lps of Row 4, sl st in each of next 34 sts, ch 2, turn, working in rem free lps of Row 6, sl st in next 34 sts, ch 1, turn, working in rem free lps of Row 8, sl st in next 36 sts, ch 2, turn, working in rem free lps of Row 10, sl st in next 36 sts, turn, ch 1, working in rem free lps of Row 12, sl st in next 34 sts, ch 2, turn, working in rem free lps of Row 14, sl st in next 34 sts, ch 1, fasten off.

Finishing

Thread tapestry needle with rem length from Row 28, matching sts, sew side seam and across toe opening.

Turn ankle section down 2½ inches.
