

# GARTER ST 4 POINT HAT

■■■■■ BEGINNER

## SIZES

Child's size 4-6 yrs (Adult's size)

## MATERIALS

Parsons Sheelard Chunky (100 g/3.5 oz)		
Storm Ragg (03107)		
Sizes	Child's	Adult's
	1	2
	ball(s)	

Size 6 mm (U.S. 10) knitting needles or size needed to obtain tension.

**TENSION:** 13 sts and 24 rows = 4 ins [10 cm] in garter st.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for Child's size. If changes are necessary for Adult's size the instructions will be written thus ( ). For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Cast on 60 (67) sts.

Work in garter st (knit every row) until work from beginning (beg) measures 8 (10½) ins [20.5 (26.5) cm]. Cast off.

Fold work in half and sew side edges together (tog) to form center back seam (see Diagram I on this page and Sewing Garter Edges on page 15). Turn Hat wrong side (WS) out and fold top of Hat into a star shape (see Diagram II).

Sew top using flat seam (see Diagram III). Turn Hat right side (RS) out and fold lower edge back to form cuff. ▲

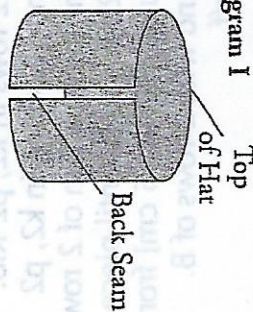
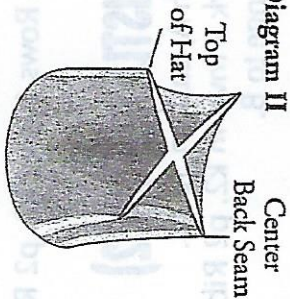
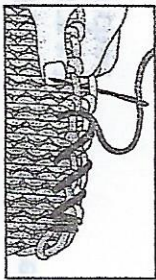

Diagram III



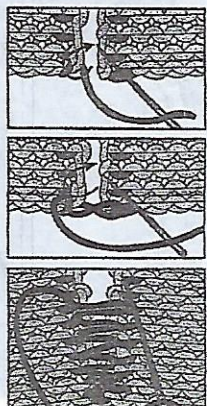
## ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning    st(s) = stitch(es)  
 WS = wrong side    tog = together  
 RS = right side

## SEWING GARTER EDGES

Thread yarn end through blunt ended large eye needle. Working with the right side facing, insert needle into first ridge at bottom of work. Draw needle through ridge on opposite side of seam. Continue drawing needle through alternating ridges at each side of seam.

After you have joined a few rows, pull the yarn, but not too tightly, to merge the 2 sides together (tog).



Continue the process to the end seam. Cut the yarn leaving a 6 in [15 cm] end. Weave the end in seam as shown on page 6.
