



GAUGE: 27 sts = 8"; 28 rows = 4" in Garter st with 2 strands held together. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

HAT

With 2 strands held together as one throughout, cast on 57 sts. Work in Garter st (knit every row) until 6½" from beginning.

Shape Crown

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K6] 7 times – 50 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K5] 7 times – 43 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K4] 7 times – 36 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K3] 7 times – 29 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K2] 7 times – 22 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog, K1] 7 times – 15 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, [K2tog] 7 times – 8 sts.

Cut yarn leaving an 18" tail. Weave yarn tail through remaining sts and pull tightly to close top. Fasten securely. Sew back seam. Weave in ends.

FINISHING (Optional)

Make a large pom-pom and secure at center top of hat.

Knitting Needles: 6mm [US 10].

Yarn needle.

Optional: pom pom maker.
