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Skill Level: Easy / Intermediate Size: Approx. 38" Around x 9" High Materials: Cascade Yarns® Pacific® 60% Acrylic / 40% Superwash Merino Wool 100 g (3.5 oz) / 213 yds (195 m) 2 skeins of color #98 (Deep Sea Coral) US 8/32" circular knitting needle Stitch marker Yarn Needle

20 sts = 5" in pattern (4 sts =1")

Gauge:

Abbreviations:

BO	= Bind Off
CO	= Cast On
K	= Knit
K2tog	= Knit 2 stitches together
Р	= Purl
Rnd(s)	= Round(s)
St(s)	= Stitch(es)
SKP	= Slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass the slipped st over the knit st & off the needle (decrease 1 st).
SK2P	= Slip 1 st, knit 2 sts together (K2tog), pass the slipped st over the st created by the k2tog & off the needle (decrease 2 sts).
YO	= Yarn Over

Begin Pattern:

CO 162 sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker to mark beginning of the rnd. Rnd 1: P

Rnd 2: K

Rnd 3: P

Start pattern:

Rnd 1: *(K1, YO, SKP, K1, K2tog, YO); repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: Knit

Rnd 3: *(K2, YO, SK2P, YO, K1); repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: Knit

Repeat rounds 1-4 until desired length. Model repeats the pattern 15 times

- Edging:
- Rnd 1: P
- Rnd 2: K
- Rnd 3: P

Finishing: BO. Weave in all ends and block if necessary.

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
