

Neck Cowl

Directions below photo



Approx. Finished Size: 6 x 24" before sewing

Materials:

Ecco Baby Camel (shown in color 200):
4 --50g hanks.

Gauge:

16 sts = 4" on a US 9 needle over st st.

Needles:

US 9, or size necessary to obtain given gauge 1 large button.

Skill Level: Intermediate

C4F = Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in front; knit next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts from the cable needle.

C4B = Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in back; knit next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts from the cable needle.

T3F = Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in front; purl next st, knit the 2 sts from the cable needle.

T3B = Slip next st onto a cable needle and hold in back; knit next 2 sts, purl the st from the cable needle.

T4F = Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in front; purl next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts from the cable needle.

T4B = Slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold in back; knit next 2 sts, purl the 2 sts from the cable needle.

Wrap scarf:

Loosely cast on 30 sts. Knit 1 row. Begin pattern:

Row 1(WS): K1, p1, k3, p4, (k4, p4) twice, k3, p1, k1.

Row 2(RS): P1, k1, p3, C4B, (p4, C4B) twice, p3, k1, p1.

Row 3: As row 1.

Row 4: P1, k1, p2, T3B, (T4F, T4B) twice, T3F, p2, k1, p1.

Row 5: K1, p1, k2, p2, k3, p4, k4, p4, k3, p2, k2, p1, k1.

Row 6: P1, k1, p1, T3B, p3, C4F, p4, C4B, p3, T3F, p1, k1, p1.

Row 7: K1, p1, k1, p2, k4, (p4, k4) twice, p2, k1, p1, k1.

ABBREVIATIONS: alt = alternate, bo = bind off, beg = begin(ing), CO = cast on, cont. = continue, dec = decrease, foll = following, inc = increase, k = knit, k2tog = knit two together, meas = measures, pass = pass slip stitch over, p = purl, patt = pattern, PU = pick up, RS = right side, rem = remain(ing), sl = slip, SSK = slip 1 st as if to knit, slip a second st as if to knit, knit them together through the back loop, st(s) = stitch(es), st st = stockinette st, tbl = through back loop, tog = together, WS = Wrong Side, yo = yarn over.

Row 8 (Second time through only): P1, k1, p1, k1, yo, p2tog, p2, T3B, T4F, T4B, T3F, p3, k2, p1, k1, p1.

Row 8(ALL OTHER TIMES): P1, k1, p1, k2, p3, T3B, T4F, T4B, T3F, p3, k2, p1, k1, p1.

Row 9: K1, p1, k1, (p2, k3) twice, p4, (k3, p2) twice, k1, p1, k1.

Row 10: P1, k1, p1, (k2, p3) twice, C4B, (p3, k2) twice, p1, k1, p1.

Row 11: As row 9.

Row 12: P1, k1, p1, k2, p3, T3F, T4B, T4F, T3B, p3, k2, p1, k1, p1.

Row 13: As row 7.

Row 14: P1, k1, p1, T3F, p3, C4F, p4, C4B, p3, T3B, p1, k1, p1.

Row 15: As row 5.

Row 16: P1, k1, p2, T3F, (T4B, T4F) twice, T3B, p2, k1, p1.

Repeat rows 1-16, until total length measures about 24", or desired length, ending with a RS row. Knit 1 row. Bind off.

FINISHING: Fold beginning edge over ending edge and sew up outside seams only over area crossed. Leave inside seams open. Sew 1 button on inside piece to correspond to buttonhole on top piece. Weave in all ends.
