## Rib-A-Roni Hat

DESIGNED BY JANE TANNER


Materials
Sizes (to fit head circumference
Baby 15-16" (Child 17-18", Small 19-20"), [Medium 21-22", Large 23+"]
Recommended: Child size for ages 2-4 and Small size for ages 5-8. However, kids' head size measurements can vary. When in doubt, make a bigger size.

## Yarn

Worsted Weight, 28 (43, 49), [57, 71] gm in 1 or more colors [Note: 3-6 gm for optional stripe]
Needles
16 circular and dpns, US 7/4.5 mm
Gauge
Approx. 4.75 sts $/ 1^{\prime \prime}$, but gauge is not critical; finished hats from $15^{\prime \prime}$ to 22 " will find a cold head to keep warm

Abbreviations: K: knit; K2tog: knit 2 sts together; K2togtbl: knit 2 sts tog through back loops; P: purl; p2tog: purl 2 sts tog; p2togtbl: purl 2 sts tog through back loops [may substitute with regular p2tog, if desired]; Ssk: sl 1 knit-wise, sl 1 purl-wise, move both sts back to left needle and k2togtbl; Sts: stitches; tog: together; [...] repeat enclosed instructions as specified.

## PATTERN NOTE

If more than one color is being used, work approx. 2" before changing colors.

## DIRECTIONS

Cast on $64,(72,80),[88,96]$ sts loosely. Join, being careful not to twist, and place marker. Establish rib pattern for size (NOTE: Each size has its own distinct rib pattern):

- Baby: [k4, p1, k2, p1] 8 times.
- Child: [k4, p1, k3, p1] 8 times.
- Small: [k4, p1, k4, p1] 8 times.
- Medium: [k4, p1, k2, p1, k2, p1] 8 times.
- Large: $[k 4, \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 2, \mathrm{p} 2, \mathrm{k} 2, \mathrm{p} 1] 8$ times.

For Baby, Child, and Small sizes: Work rib pattern for $4(5,5.5)$ " from cast-on. Continue with Setup Round for Crown Shaping.

For Medium and Large sizes only: Work rib pattern for $1.5^{\prime \prime}$ from cast-on, then change the rib pattern as follows:
Medium: [k4, p1, k5, p1] 8 times.
Large: [k4, p1, k6, p1] 8 times.
Work in new rib pattern until hat measures [6, 6.5]" total from cast-on.

## Setup Round for Crown Shaping (all sizes):

At beginning of round, remove marker, $k 2$, replace first marker; this $1^{\text {st }}$ marker is the new location for the beginning of rounds).
*Work in rib pattern for $16(18,20),[22,24]$ sts, place marker (this is the $2^{\text {nd }}$ marker); repeat from * two more times to place $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ markers, then work to the end of the round in established rib, ending with a k2. The stitches should be evenly divided between the 4 markers as follows: 16 (18, 20), [22, 24] sts between markers.

## Crown Shaping:

In the following instructions, work Rounds 9-18 for Baby (7-18 for Child, 5-18 for Small), [3-18 for Medium, 118 for Large]
For Large size only:
Round 1 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k5, p1, k4, p1, k5, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 88 sts
Round 2: [K2, p1, k5, p1, k4, p1, k5, p1, k2] 4 times.
For Medium and Large sizes only:
Round 3 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k4, p1, k4, p1, k4, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 80 sts
Round 4: [K2, p1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k4, p1, k2] 4 times.
For Small, Medium and Large only:
Round 5 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k3, p1, k4, p1, k3, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 72 sts
Round 6: [K2, p1, k3, p1, k4, p1, k3, p1, k2] 4 times.
For child, small, medium and large only:
Round 7 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k2, p1, k4, p1, k2, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 64 sts
Round 8: *K2, p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k2, p1, k2;* repeat 3 more times.
For all sizes:
Round 9 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 56 sts
Round 10: [K2, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k2] 4 times.
Round 11 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, p1, k4, p1, p2tog, k2] 4 times. -48 sts
Round 12: [K2, p2, k4, p2, k2] 4 times.
Round 13 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k4, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 40 sts
Round 14: [K2, p1, k4, p1, k2] 4 times.
Round 15 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, k2, p2tog, k2] 4 times. -32 sts
Round 16 (decrease): [k2, p2togtbl, p2tog, k2] 4 times. - 24 sts
Round 17 (decrease): [k1, ssk, k2tog, k1] 4 times. - 16 sts
Round 18 (decrease): [ssk, k2tog] 4 times. -8 sts
Cut 8 " yarn tail and pull through last 8 sts on the needles. Weave in all ends.
