58-7748 VICTORIAN CROCHETED CHRISTMAS TREE WITH TREE SKIRT

FINISHED SIZE:

Tree: Approximately 12-in. high x 7-in. wide Skirt: Approximately 14-in. across center.

MATERIALS:

- 100% acrylic afghan weight yarn; used double throughout: Bone (A) and Dark Victorian Rose (C)
- 95% acrylic-5% metallic 4-ply worsted weight yarn (used as is): Ombre (B)
- Tapestry needle
- · 18-in. piece of rug canvas
- · Gold-colored filigree ornaments
- Dark green floss

YOU WILL NEED:

- Size H-8 aluminum crochet hook or size to reach gauge
- · Sewing needle

STITCHES USED:

Chain, slip stitch, single, double, half double, and treble crochet, plus the following variations:

Picot (p): Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook—picot made.

Double Treble Crochet (dtr): Yo 3 times, insert hook into st and draw lp through, (yo and draw through 2 lps on hook) 4 times.

GAUGE:

8 dc = 2 in., 4 mds (dc) = 2-in. (radius) or $4^{1/4}$ -in. (diameter), first 8 rnds of cone = $3^{1/2}$ -in. high

If you are getting more stitches to the inch, you are working tightly and should change to a larger size hook. If you are getting fewer stitches to the inch, you are working loosely and should change to a smaller size hook. Check your gauge as you progress to assure the correct size.

*, **-Directions following *, ** are to be repeated the number of times specified.

DIRECTIONS:

NOTE: The tree is worked as follows: first a coneshaped foundation is crocheted about 11 ½ in. high (and 8 in. wide at base, when laid flat). Then the branches are worked onto the lps in a continuous spiral.

Tree:

Cone:

- ☐ Starting at tip with Color B, ch 4, join with sl st to form ring.
- ☐ Rnd 1: Ch 3, work 5 dc in ring; sl st in top of ch 3.
- ☐ Rnd 2: Ch 3, work 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc) twice. Join with sl st in top of ch 3—9 dc (counting ch 3 as 1 dc).

Note: Next rnd starts the ch-6 lps. Branches are attached to these lps after cone-shaped base is completed.

- Rnd 3 (lp rnd): [*Ch 6, sc in next 3 dc; rep from around, ending ch 6, sc in last 2 dc; sl st in sl st at base of first lp] changing to 2 strands of Color A in last step of sc, do not fasten off 4-ply, work remainder of cone using 2-ply doubled, but allow Ombre yarn to dangle outside of cone (three ch-6 lps/9 sc). Mark the first lp of first round for start of branches.
- Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in same st as ch 3; *holding lp forward, sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc; rep from * ending dc in last 2 sc; sl st in top of ch 3—12 dc (counting ch 3 as 1 dc).
- Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 3 bet []'s—(four ch-6 lps).
- ☐ Rnd 6: Ch 3, *sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 3 sc; rep from *, ending dc in last 2 sc; sl st in top of ch 3—12 dc.
- Rnd 7: Rep Rnd 3 bet []'s (except, working 4 lps—12 sc).
- Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 4—(16 dc). Measures 3 1/2-in. high.
- Rnd 9: *Ch 6, sc in next 4 dc. Rep from *, ending sc in last 3 dc; sl st in sl st—(4 lps).
- ☐ Rnd 10: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, *sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 3 sc, 2 dc in next sc. Rep from *, ending dc in last 3 sc; sl st in ch 3—(20 dc).
- Rnd 11: Rep Rnd 9—(5 lps).
- Rnd 12: Ch 3, *sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 4 sc. Rep from *, ending dc in last 3 sc; sl st in ch 3.
- Rnd 13: Rep Rnd 9-(5 lps).
- Rnd 14: Rep Rnd 10.
- Rnd 15: *Ch 6, sc in next 5 dc. Rep from *, ending sc in last 4 dc; sl st in sl st—(5 lps).
- Rnd 16: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, *sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 4 sc, 2 dc in next sc. Rep from *, ending dc in last 4 sc; sl st in ch 3.
- Rnd 17: Rep Rnd 15—(6 lps).
- ☑ Rnd 18: Ch 3, *sk next ch-6 lp, dc in next 5 sc. Rep from *, ending dc in last 4 sc; sl st in ch 3.
- Rnd 19: *Ch 6, sc in next 4 dc. Rep from *, ending sc in last 5 dc; sl st in sl st—(7 lps/29 sc).
- □ Rnd 20: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st, *sk next

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

HAND WASHING AND DRYING:

(Remove canvas and ornaments before washing.)

Wash gently in warm water using any detergent which does not contain bleaching agents. Always support the article during washing and rinsing and when removing article from cold rinse. Bunch together and lift out in both hands. Squeeze out excess water. Roll inside a towel and gently squeeze again while in the towel. Spread article to dry on a flat surface, bunch into shape and allow to dry thoroughly before moving article. Never dry any article in direct sunlight and never hang to dry.
