Sugar Glider Tree Hole Bag Crochet Pattern (SGB03-B-PAT)

Materials:

 4.00mm / G Crochet Hook (or size needed to obtain gauge).

 Tapestry Needle.











 Stitch Marker



Medium Worsted / Size 4 acrylic yarn.

Color A - Dark Brown
Color B - Camel
Color C - Dark Green
Color D - Lime Green

Abbreviation & Symbol Key:

Ch	Chain	
Sc	Single crochet	
Hdc	Half double crochet	
Dc	Double crochet	
Tr	Treble crochet	
Dtr	Double treble crochet	
Ss	Slip stitch	
2tog/3tog	Decrease	
Bl	Back loop	
Fl	Front loop	

Notes:

1. Pattern is written from center base of bag.
2. If your joining stitch strays to the side, try to adjust back to center when starting the next round.
3. Do not count the chain stitch as a stitch at the beginning of round.
4. When joining at end of round always join to the top of the chain stitch you began the round with.

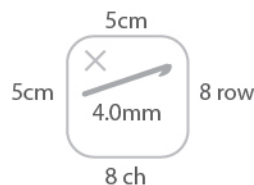
5. Do not count stitches base on images. Images used are for reference only.

How to read the pattern:

1. For symbol diagram pattern
 - a. Refer to page 5 - 6
 - b. When you see red arrow, it is pointing at start point of a diagram.
 - c. When you see coloured symbol, they are either referring to the large size only stitch or to work with different color yarn.
2. For written abbreviation pattern
 - a. Refer to page 2
 - b. When you see parenthesis () in the pattern they are either referring to the numbers for the larger sizes.
 - c. When you see Brackets [] in the pattern, that means that you work everything in them as a set or together.
 - d. When I have a number followed by a st, that stitch needs to be worked over that number of stitches.

Gauge:

Medium Worsted / Size 4 - Work 8 sts & 8 rows in sc to measure 5 x 5cm / 2 x 2in using 4.0mm / G hook, or size require to obtain tension.

Written Pattern

Bag

Round 1
Color A, slip ring / yarn ring, 1 ch, 6 sc. Join with ss. At the end of round you should have 6 total sts.

Round 2

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st] 6 times. Join with ss. 12 total sts.

Round 3

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 1 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 18 total sts.

Round 4

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 2 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 24 total sts.

Round 5

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 3 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 30 total sts.

Round 6

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 4 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 36 total sts.

Round 7

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 42 total sts.

Round 8

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 6 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 48 total sts.

Round 9

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 7 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 54 total sts.

Round 10

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 8 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 60 total sts.

Round 11

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 9 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 66 total sts.

Round 12

Ch 1, [2 sc in next st, 10 sc] 6 times. Join with ss. 72 total sts.

Round 13 - 16

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. 72 st in total.

Round 17

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. Bind off. 72 st in total.

Round 18

Color B, ch 1 sc bl all way round. Join with ss. 72 st in total.

Round 19 - 22

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. 72 st in total.

Round 23

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. Bind off. 72 st in total.

Row 24

From where you bind off, right side facing, count towards right up to ch 34. Reattach, ch 1 to raise, sc2tog, 65 sc, sc2tog. 67 total sts. Turn.

Row 25

Ch 1 to raise, sc2tog, 63 sc, sc2tog. 65 total sts. Turn.

Row 26

Ch 1 to raise, sc2tog, 61 sc, sc2tog. 63 total sts. Turn.

Row 27 - 30

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. Bind off. 63 st in total.

Row 31

Ch 1 to raise, 2 sc in next st, 61 sc, 2 sc in next st. 65 total sts. Turn.

Row 32

Ch 1 to raise, 2 sc in next st, 63 sc, 2 sc in next st. 67 total sts. Turn.

Row 33

Ch 1 to raise, 2 sc in next st, 65 sc, 2 sc in next st. 69 total sts. Turn.

Round 34

Ch 1 to raise, 69 sc, ch 4. Hook the 1st sc in this row. Join with ss. 73 total sts.



Round 35 - 41

Ch 1, sc all way round. Join with ss. 73 st in total.

Round 42

Ch 1, 4 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 6 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 5 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 9 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 5 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 5 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 6 sc, ch 6, skip 3, 4 sc. Join with ss. 97 st in total.



Round 43

Ch 1,
3 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
4 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
3 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
3 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
7 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
3 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
3 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
4 sc, 8 sc over 6 ch from previous round,
3 sc. Join with ss. Bind off. 97 st in total.



Tree Hole

Find last stitch in row 24. Reattach with color A, ch 1 to raise, sc all the way round. Join with ss. 28 total sts in round.



Net (trellis pattern)

Row 1

With color B, ch 21 (place a red marker at ch 16), 1 sc in 9th ch from hook, [ch 5, skip 2, 1 sc] 4 times. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 2

Ch 3 to raise, ch 3, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row, [ch 5, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row] 4 times, ch 2, 1 tr over 16th chain from foundation row where red marker is. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 3

Ch 1 to raise, [ch 5, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row] 5 times. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 4

Ch 3 to raise, ch 3, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row, [ch 5, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row] 4 times, ch 2, 1 tr. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 5

Ch 1 to raise, [ch 5, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row] 5 times. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 6

Ch 3 to raise, ch 3, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row, [ch 5, 1 sc over a chain loop from previous row] 4 times, ch 2, 1 tr. 30 total sts. Turn.

Row 7

Ch 1 to raise, [ch 2, 1sc over a chain loop from previous row,] 5 times. 15 total sts. Bind off with long ends of 20cm.

You are now done with the net. Let's sew it to the bag.

Turn the bag inside out. Place the net over tree hole. Sew the top part of the net to the bag with that 20cm long ends.

Now, mark all 7 buttons position and sew buttons to the bag.



The top 2 buttons are to hold the net when it is open.



Cord

The Foundation Single Crochet is a method of combining the chain foundation and the first row of single crochet into one row. An FSC cord is bulkier, but it retains the elasticity of the chain stitch or double chain cord. Its weight is most suitable for this project.

Step 1

Chain 2, insert hook under top 2 strands of 2nd ch from hook, yarn over, draw up a loop, chain 1, yarn over hook and draw

through 2 loops on hook (sc).

Step 2

Next, work in chain underneath the last sc, insert hook under the front and back loop, yarn over, draw up a loop, chain 1, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (sc).

Repeat step 2 until desire length. Here I'm suggesting 50cm long.

Bind off with long ends.

Pull the cord in and out thru all 6 holes.

Lastly, used the long end to join this end of cord other other end to make a circle.

Fern Leaves

Small

Row 1

To begin, ch 18. This work as the foundation chain.

First side, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 7 ch.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two small leaves made.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two medium leaves made.

Ss in 1st foundation ch. You should have reached the bottom of the foundation ch now. Ch 2.

Second side, you will now be working up the opposite side of the foundation chain. Ss in each of the first 3 ch. This forms the bottom of the stem. Now, mirroring the leaves made on the first side.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two medium leaves made.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2

ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two small leaves made.

[2 sc in the next foundation ch. 1 Ss in the next foundation ch.] 3 times. Bind off with long ends.

Medium

Row 1

To begin, ch 24. This work as the foundation chain.

First side, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next ch.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two small leaves made.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two medium leaves made.

[Ch 6, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 4 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two large leaves made.

[Ch 7, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 5 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 4 times. Four extra large leaves made.

Ss in 1st foundation ch. You should have reached the bottom of the foundation ch now. Ch 2.

Second side, you will now be working up the opposite side of the foundation chain. Ss in each of the first 3 ch. This forms the bottom of the stem.

Now, mirroring the leaves made on the first side.

[Ch 7, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 5 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 4 times. Four extra large leaves made.

[Ch 6, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 4 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two large leaves made.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2

times. Two medium leaves made.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Two small leaves made. Bind off with long ends.

Large

Row 1

To begin, ch 28. This work as the foundation chain.

First side, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next ch.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

[Ch 6, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 4 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

[Ch 7, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 5 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

Ch 8, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 6 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.

Ss in 1st foundation ch. You should have reached the bottom of the foundation ch now. Ch 2.

Second side, you will now be working up the opposite side of the foundation chain. Ss in each of the first 3 ch. This forms the bottom of the stem.

Now, mirroring the leaves made on the first side.

Ch 8, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 6 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.

[Ch 7, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 5 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

[Ch 6, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 4 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

[Ch 5, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 3 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 3 times.

[Ch 4, ss in 2nd ch from hook, ss in next 2 ch. In foundation ch, ss in next 2 ch.] 2 times. Bind off with long ends.

Arrange leaves on the right side of bag base on your own preference. Mark it with markers.



Now, use a tapestry needle with long ends attach leaves to bag. Weave in all ends and you are done.

Diagram Pattern

1. Start by making bag from center base of bag with color A. Reattached with color B at round 18. Back to color A for tree holes.
2. Make the net with color B and bind off with long end that is about 20cm. Turn the bag inside out. Place the net over tree hole. Sew the top part of the net to the bag with that 20cm long ends.

Now, mark all 7 buttons position and sew buttons to the bag.

The top 2 buttons are to hold the net when it is open



3. Make cord for bag handle. And Pull the cord in and out thru all 6 holes. Lastly, used the long end to join this end of cord other other end to make a circle.

4. Finally make 3 fern leaves, S, M and L. One size each. Arrange leaves on the right side of bag base on your own preference. Mark it with markers. Use a tapestry needle with long ends attach leaves to bag. Weave in all ends and you are done.

Feel free to play with colour combination. Changing the type of yarn and colour will also produce a different result and scale, so it can be very rewarding to experiment. Enjoy!

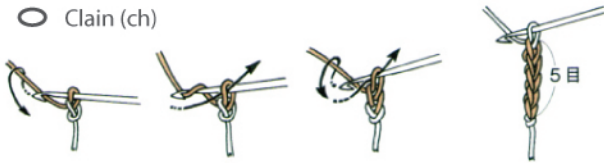

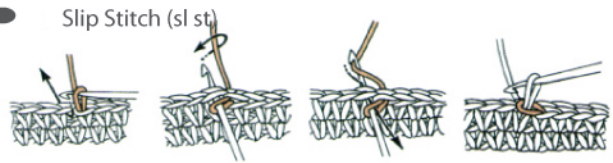

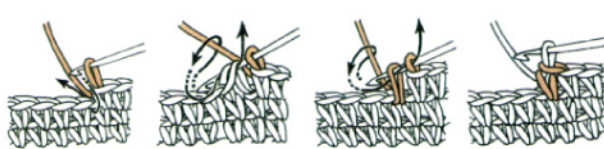

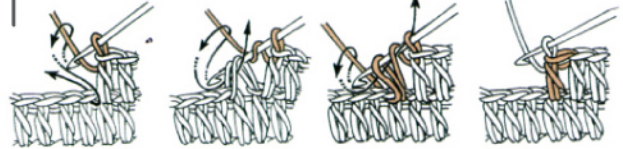

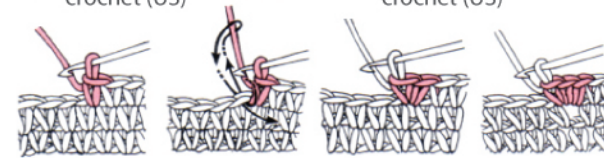

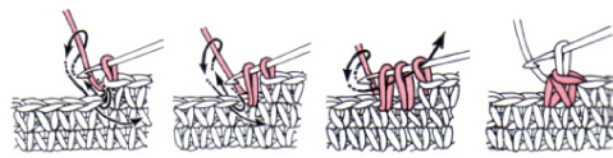

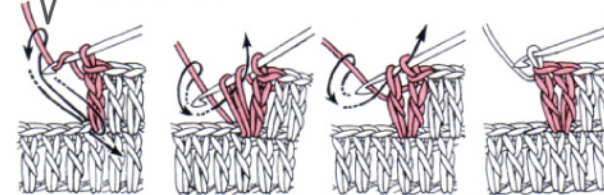

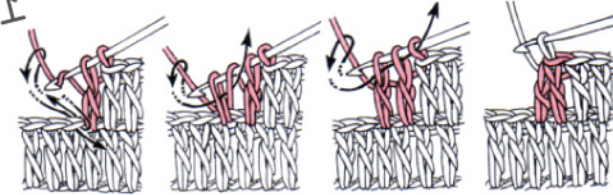

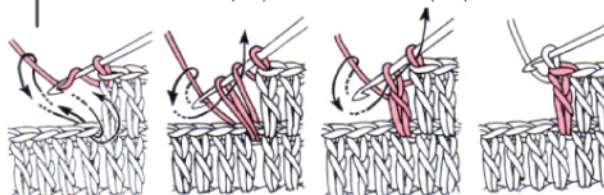

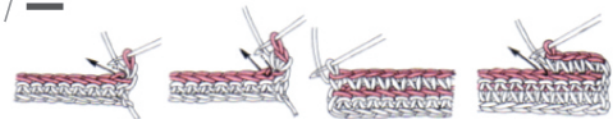
